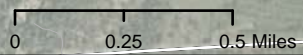






City of Mount Shasta Hispanic Majority Blocks

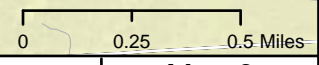






